## SUMMER COLLEGE INTERN PROGRAM

The Tribal Council has approved funding for a Summer College Intern Program. Seven students will be placed within tribal departments for 12 weeks this summer, working 40 hours per week at \$11.47 per hour.

Students must be:

- ◆ KBIC Members
- ◆ Attending college full-time during the 2017-2018 academic year and continuing during the 2018-2019 academic year. *Students seeking internships to fulfill graduation requirements during the 2017-2018 academic year will be a priority, as long as they meet the other eligibility requirements.*
- ◆ Must have a minimum GPA of 2.00
- ◆ Must provide proof of GPA, full-time status, and college major

If the number of students applying is greater than the number of positions available, the highest GPA's will be used to determine placement.

To apply, please submit your application and required documents (listed on the Checklist form) to the Personnel Office located in the Tribal Center via in person, fax (353-8068), or email ([personnel@kbic-nsn.gov](mailto:personnel@kbic-nsn.gov)). The deadline to apply is Friday, April 20th, 2018 at 4:00 p.m. Applications will be accepted after April 28th if all the positions are not filled.
