IF THE EMPLOYEE'S CURRENT WAGE IS DETERMINED TO BE APPROPRIATE OR LOWER THAN WHAT IS DETERMINED THROUGH THE RECLASSIFICATION PROCESS, THE ANNUAL RAISE WILL BE EFFECTIVE ON THEIR ANNIVERSARY DATE AND APPLIED TO THE 2015 RECLASSIFIED WAGE. C) THOSE EMPLOYEES WHO WERE NOT PROPERLY APPROVED FOR PROMOTION OR TRANSFER INTO EXISTING POSITIONS OR NEW POSITIONS DURING 2014. THE CEO IS DIRECTED TO MOVE FORWARD WITH THE CORRECTED ACTIONS AND ANNUAL RAISES FOR THOSE AFFECTED EMPLOYEES WILL BE HANDLED ON A CASE BY CASE BASIS DEPENDING ON THE OUTCOME.

D) THOSE EMPLOYEES WHOSE ANNUAL INCREASE IS IDENTIFIED IN THEIR EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT AND THOSE SERVING IN INTERIM, TEMPORARY, OR ON-CALL POSITIONS.
